Three Lakes Association (TLA) is excited to announce our Science Education and Outreach Program (SEOP) grant opportunity once again. These grants will support science and nature experiences in the 2025/2026 school year that get students interacting with the natural world and live human beings (not recordings), such as field trips, outdoor activities, and visits with experts. This grant can fund fees, equipment, or transportation to make these experiences possible. The grant application will open on March 18, 2025, with a submission deadline of April 30, 2025. The SEOP grant allows you to provide students with an enhanced environmental science experience. Previous grants have been approved for field trips to the Grass River Natural Area, Sleeping Bear Dunes, fish hatcheries, and the Great Lakes Children's Museum.
